
## Fiat Punto Model year from 1999 to 2001 All vehicles with electrical power assisted steering (City function)

## The warning light of the electrical power assisted steering lights up

If there are complaints about the above-mentioned fault, a poor plug-type connection could be the cause. Poor contacting at the blue 2-pin (1) and black 10-pin (2) connector leads to repeated interruptions, but a fault is not stored. The connectors are beneath the steering column (see fig.). In this case the connectors have to be "reworked" in such a way that secure contacting is guaranteed. To do this separate the plug-type connection and press the individual cable lugs together with the aid of a small screwdriver in such a way that higher contact pressure is achieved on the individual pins. Reinsert the connector and check the correct function of the power assisted steering.
