

Speedometer fluctuates, engine starts poorly, volume of speeddependent radio becomes quieter.

If there are complaints with these vehicles about the abovementioned faults, one possible cause is a defective speed sensor in the transmission. When troubleshooting, the resistance of the sensor can be checked. To do this, disconnect the plug from the sensor and measure the resistance between the signal output and the earth connection on the sensor. The following values apply: Fiesta model year 1998–2001: 12–18 kiloohms Fiesta model year 2002–2005: 1.4–1.6 kiloohms Focus model year 1999–2005: 1.4–1.6 kiloohms If the resistance values measured are outside the tolerance ranges, the speed sensor must be replaced.
