
Renault and PSA Tyre pressure control system with Siemens VDO "TPMS" sensors Note about programming the sensors

In everyday work in the workshop, it can become necessary to programme the tyre pressure control sensors during simple tasks such as changing tyres or repairing brakes.

With PSA and Renault vehicles that are fitted with TPMS sensors (Tire Pressure Monitoring System), a pressure of 3.7 bar must be applied to the tyres for at least 1 minute before the sensors are programmed.

The respective manufacturer's specifications must be followed exactly in advance.
